

Questions to Ask

DO-IT-YOURSELF ORTHODONTICS

1) As part of your treatment fee, do you receive any in-person visits with an orthodontist? Are you provided with comprehensive diagnostic records like x-rays/photos before your treatment?

2) Does your treatment fee include any mid treatment changes and final retainers to hold movement?

3) If an orthodontist is involved with your treatment, do you know the name of the person who is specifically involved with your case? Is their name located on the companies website somewhere?

4) How do you know if your teeth and gums are healthy enough for orthodontic treatment?

5) What are the possible risks (financial, health, etc.) associated with your orthodontic treatment?

6) What is the education, background, qualifications and/or experience with the person conducting your treatment? Is there a way for you to contact and discuss with them directly?

7) Who is responsible for detecting any issues that may occur during treatment?

8) Do they have a flexible interest free payment option? Are you able to use your insurance, flex spending, or health savings account?

9) If an emergency arises is there a person you can see or speak with right away?

10) If you are not happy with the result of your teeth when treatment is finished, how is that handled?
